Updated Specification: Agriculture, Land Management and Production (8717): Minor amendments throughout the specification

There have been some minor amendments throughout the specification, notably in **2 Centre requirements** and **5 Scheme of assessment** (as shown on the version control box) – the resource requirement for **Dairy cattle** has been added and there has been some changes to centre staff requirements. This version now includes a cover image.



Ofqual Supporting Resilience in the Exams System Updated Guidance

Following guidance from Ofqual, we have also updated our guidance to reflect the requirement around centres collecting evidence using mock exams which have been completed under exam conditions.

This evidence can then be used to support alternative methods of awarding grades, in the unlikely event that the government determines that exams cannot go ahead.

This guidance is in Section 5 of the 'Emergency Situations Affecting Assessment Delivery' City & Guilds guidance document (link below).



As part of our VTQ Checkpoint Activity in April, we are asking centres to provide estimated qualification grades as part of the submission process, however we would like to reassure you that this is not mandatory for 2024.

JCQ Updated guidance for Artificial Intelligence: Use in Assessments

The JCQ has updated its <u>Al Use in Assessment</u> guidance which we recommend you are familiar with especially around Al use in moderated / Non-Examined Assessments.


