The tasks are split into three sections:

- tasks related to gas skills
- combined tasks, incorporating gas and plumbing skills
- stretch and challenge tasks, for learners who have mastered the core skills.

Although many of the tasks are standalone, some of the combined tasks are designed to integrate into one larger task, providing learners with an opportunity to work with more complex installations.

Each task has the facility to record the time taken to complete, to enable tutors/trainers to monitor guided learning hours (GLH) where required.
