- Understand industrial and commercial hot and cold water system maintenance and fault diagnosis techniques
- Understand industrial and commercial hot water heating system maintenance and fault diagnosis techniques
- Understand industrial and commercial ventilation system maintenance and fault diagnosis techniques
- Understand industrial and commercial air conditioning system maintenance and fault diagnosis techniques
- Maintain and diagnose faults on H&V industrial and commercial systems

This is a Framework qualification.

Who could take this qualification? OR who is this qualification suitable for?

This qualification is suitable for those who wish to pursue a career in planned and reactive maintenance roles within the heating and ventilating industry. Ideally you should have taken the Level 2 NVQ Diploma in Planned and Reactive Maintenance on Heating and Ventilating Systems (600/0143/4) qualification or have an understanding of the basic skills involved in heating and ventilating maintenance tasks.
