#### Scenario

Tablet Computers UKINC have recently employed you as a web designer, they want to create a website that hopefully will sell the 10 top Tablet PC's that are available to customers in the UK via their website. The company has asked you to produce the website that meets their needs. You can obtain a list of Tablet PC's and prices from the assessor.

Read all of the instructions carefully and complete the tasks in the order given.

#### Task A - Design

- Tablet Computers UK INC initially asked you to design a three to (maximum) four page website that advertises their range of Tablet PCs. The design needs to include the following:
  - Layout of each page or a navigation diagram / Story board
  - The format of content including CSS
  - Any interactive features
  - Shopping cart
  - Images
  - Any animation.

The plans can either be hand drawn or produced using ICT

#### Task B - Build

Following the plans created in Task A, build the three or four page website that describes the Tablet PCs and gives their prices.

Ensure your finished website includes the following:

- Three or four pages
- Images of the products with descriptions of the features and functions
- Navigation between **each** page
- **Two** interactive features
- A shopping cart
- One animation.

#### Task C - Test

- 1 Now that your website is complete ask the assessor to observe you whilst you complete the following tests:
  - Functionality testing, open your website in **two** different web browsers
  - Demonstrate your navigation to ensure each link works as described in your design
  - Demonstrate your interactive features.

- 2 Briefly state the role of the following protocols:

  - Web hosting services
  - Domain name registrars.
- 4 List **three** different types of web functionality.
- 5 Briefly state the purpose of Mark-Up languages. List **two** examples of a Mark-Up language.

- 6 Identify the roles of the following in building websites and or web applications:
  - Web runtime environments
  - Web application programming languages
  - Databases.
- 7 Identify **one** typical stack combination that can be used for web development.
