Simulation assessment and questioning	Internet access and suitable equipment for remote assessment, such as a computer with audio and video capacity, as outlined in the manual for End-point Assessment services.					
	A suitable, quiet room for the remote questioning to take place (under exam conditions). The room should have lighting, space and privacy and be free from interruptions. It must be away from the pressures of work activities, in a controlled environment. This may be on or off the employers' premises.					
	A suitable, quiet room for the simulation assessment to take place. It must be away from the pressures of work activities, in a controlled environment. There will be a dedicated workstation with access to all the required equipment and with someone allocated as a responsible person by the employer, or by the centre, who is responsible for the controlled environment and ensures that the work is the apprentice's own.					
	A computer or laptop with the latest version of Packet Tracer installed.					
Professional discussion underpinned by a portfolio	A suitable, quiet room for the remote professional discussion to take place (under exam conditions). The room should have lighting, space and privacy and be free from interruptions. It must be away from the pressures of work activities, in a controlled environment. This may be on or off the employers' premises.					
	The apprentice and the IEPA must each have a copy of the apprentice's portfolio of evidence to refer to.
