- Perm and neutralise hair
- Plait and twist hair
- Temporarily attach hair to enhance a style
- Assist with shaving services
- Fulfil salon reception duties
- · Colour and lighten men's hair

This is a Framework qualification.







WHAT COULD THIS QUALIFICATION LEAD TO?

Learners achieving this qualification can gain employment in a salon as a Barber, carrying out day to day tasks such as:

- customer service
- shampooing hair
- · cutting hair
- · preparing for shaving services
- · cut facial hair
- · colouring services.

Learners could progress onto an apprenticeship at Level 3, in either barbering or hairdressing, or other qualifications such as:
