WHAT COULD THIS QUALIFICATION LEAD TO?

Learners achieving this qualification can gain employment in a salon as a Salon Assistant, carrying out day to day tasks such as:

- preparing for services
- maintaining work areas
- shampooing hair
- blow drying hair
- assisting with a variety of salon services.

Learners could progress onto an apprenticeship at Level 2, in either hairdressing or barbering, or other qualifications such as:
