Learners are able to work either full time or part time whilst gaining this qualification, because it is a one day course which suits the employer's business needs.

We currently run the Level 3 Patisserie and Confectionary Course, which learners feel that without the training being given at South Essex College to gain this qualification and being released from their full-time employment one day a week, would find it difficult to increase their own knowledge and skills. The support by their employers to gain this qualification will directly impact on their business, as their professional skill level, knowledge and reputation will improve; therefore providing an opportunity to increase income and profitability within the trade.

On completion of this qualification, learners could progress to being self-employed or pursue a career as a pastry chef.
