# What does this qualification cover?

This qualification covers the advanced practical skills and knowledge required to work in mattress making roles within the furnishings industry.

You will take the following mandatory units

- Design schemes in furnishings
- Health and safety within furniture and furnishing making environments
- Mattress quilting operations
- Modern mattress making
- Production planning in furniture and furnishing making
- Supervision in a furniture and furnishing making environment
- Traditional mattress manufacture

and then choose from the following optional units

- Produce drawings using CAD
- Prototype design in modern upholstery

This is a Framework qualification.

Who could take this qualification? OR who is this qualification suitable for

This qualification is suitable if you wish to pursue a career in mattress making within the furnishings industry. Ideally you should already have taken the 'Level 2 Diploma in Mattress Making' (600/3196/7) or have an understanding of basic mattress making skills.

This qualification is suitable if you are aged 14 years old or over.
