OVERVIEW

What does this qualification cover?

This qualification covers the occupational practical skills and knowledge required to work in supervisory roles within the furniture, furnishings and interiors industry.

There are a wide variety of units covering all aspects of supervision including team monitoring and team building and feedback mechanisms and also units on producing complex items of furniture and furnishings.

You will take a mixture of mandatory units and optional units depending on your role profile within your workplace.

This is a Framework qualification.

Who could take this qualification? OR who is this qualification suitable for?

This qualification is suitable if you have been working within the furniture, furnishings and interiors industry for some time and are managing a team in your job. You should already have completed a Level 2 furniture or furnishings qualification or be in possession of the skills associated with advanced furniture and furnishings production.

This qualification is suitable for you if you are 16 years old or over. However you need to be employed in a furniture, furnishings or interiors company in order that you can gather the evidence to demonstrate that you are competent in this qualification as you will be assessed in the workplace by a portfolio of evidence.
