## 600/1196/8 Level 2 Diploma in Vehicle Parts Competence

## **OVERVIEW**

· What does this qualification cover?

This qualification covers the knowledge and skills required to work competently as a Parts advisor.

Parts advisors are also known as vehicle parts operatives. They are responsible for ordering, selling and managing stock control on a wide range of vehicle parts and accessories.

Duties may vary from employer to employer but will typically include:

- Advising customers on how to solve a problem with their vehicle
- Taking orders from customers both face to face and over the phone
- Maintaining an ordered stock room and finding parts from stock
- · Raising invoices for parts sold
- Liaison with other members of staff

Customers may include members of the public, service departments of dealerships, and garages.

Other non-technical but essential skills also include:

- A good technical understanding and general knowledge of how motor vehicles work
- Good communication skills
- Willingness to keep technical knowledge updated in order to provide the most efficient service possible
- Confidence in processing payments
- The ability to work on your own initiative and as part of a team
- Confidence in problem solving

This is a Framework qualification.









Who could take this qualification?

This is a practical qualification for Parts Advisors who want to demonstrate their skills on the job, in their own workplace.

## WHAT COULD THIS QUALIFICATION LEAD TO?

Learners who are successful will have proved they are able to work competently at the standard expected for a Parts Advisor.

In terms of further training, learners could register upon completion on to the Level 3 Diploma in Vehicle Parts Principles (600/1200/6) to acquire the skills required to move into the next level.

In addition, they could take up a Level 3 Advanced Apprenticeship in Vehicle Parts to become a Parts Sales Representative.
