What makes up a Modern Apprenticeship?

Modern Apprenticeships combine vocational learning with practical, on-the-job experience and training. They enable apprentices to develop their skills through industry-recognised qualifications, whilst getting paid. Most Modern Apprenticeship programmes take between 18 and 24 months depending on the industry sector and ability of the apprentice.

Automotive Modern Apprenticeships consist of the following main elements:

- SVQ or competency-based component.
- Knowledge-based or Technical Certificate component (VRQ).
- Core Skills.

The best way is to register them under one of the automotive packages (9422) as this registration will give you access to all the qualifications which are part of that apprenticeship framework and would also be more economical that making a registration for each of the qualifications individually.

How do I claim results for transferable units?

To claim transferable results, you submit them through the Walled Garden. In the case of online tests, you need to submit the results with a Pass by using the proxy components through the Walled Garden (they are called 'credit transfer for...' and the title of the unit), not the online test number.
