NB: These figures refer only to candidates entered for and taking key skills tests through City & Guilds centres. The level 1-2 tests are also available online; figures for these are collated separately and are therefore not included here.

Candidates may attempt the same test any number of times in the course of working towards a key skills qualification so these should not be taken to imply overall 'success rates', merely the proportion who were successful during particular test opportunities.
