Page 4 - spreadsheet scenario for questions 9 to 19

An error has been found in the Key Skills IT Level 1 paper. On Page 4, the spreadsheet heading 'Summary' in cell reference H1 is incorrectly presented on one line (see question 15 below). It should be split over two lines, i.e. the character 'y' in 'Summary' should appear on the second line.

15 To make the word Summary in cell H1 appear on one line, the user should change the

- A column width
- B orientation
- C row height
- D margins
