


• e-learning bites follow a 'see it', 'try it' and 'test it' format and can be accessed on PCs, tablets and mobile devices; allowing learners to approach and consolidate topics independently.




e-Functional Skills – key facts

- Initial and diagnostic assessment used to generate Individual Learning Plans (ILP)
- Lesson builder and content import/export tools allow content to be customised and usage monitored
- 'Test your knowledge' to help learners consolidate learning and check progress
- Vocational top-ups provide additional sector-specific learning content
 - currently available for Construction, Care and Hair & Beauty
- Sample assessments
 - taken directly from our sample assessments, so structure/approach consistent

e-Functional Skills – features

1. INITIAL ASSESSMENT AND DIAGNOSTIC





13. EXTERNAL ASSESSMENT

When test ready learners can sit their external assessment. Flexible assessment options are available with a choice of onscreen and paper assessments available on demand.



12. PRACTICE TESTS

Developed by City & Guilds assessment experts, learners can access a series of practice tests. The practice tests help enable the learner to become familiar with the final assessment model and build confidence before the external assessment.



11. ADDITIONAL e-LEARNING CONTENT

Tutors and learners can access additional e-learning content to help revise topics the learner is still finding difficult and provide a final brush up of knowledge before the final assessment.



10. EXPORT CONTENT TO VLE FOR CLASSROOM TEACHING

The system allows users to export a SCORM pack of pages or resources which can then be imported into a centres' learning platform



9. IMPORT OWN CONTENT

Centres can upload their own resources and useful web links. For example a centre could choose to upload their own Level 3 content to stretch and prepare a learner for higher levels of attainment.

Adaptive Initial Assessment and Diagnostic tests assess learner's skills level and knowledge gaps.

2. e-ILP



Based on the results of the Initial Assessment and Diagnostic tests an Individual Learning Plan (e-ILP) is generated. The e-ILP is targeted towards the learners' areas of weakness.



8. INDIVIDUAL OR COHORT LESSON BUILDER TOOL

Lesson builder functionality allows tutors to build bespoke lesson plans for cohorts, small groups or individual learners.

3. DYNAMIC e-LEARNING



Tutors and learners can access a wealth of engaging and dynamic e-learning content. 340 maths and English tutorials are available to assist learners develop their knowledge and check their progress.

4. FORMATIVE TESTS



Formative practice tests help build learner confidence, structure learning and track learner progress through computer marked assessments.

5. CLEAR LEARNER NAVIGATION



Learners interact through an intuitive learner landing page which highlights learners 'Latest work' and features navigation tabs to 'Lessons', 'To do List' and 'How am I doing?'


6. REPORTING AND ANALYTICS



In depth reporting and analytics tools allow tutors to monitor learner interaction and progress.

7. TUTOR INTERVENTION AND INTERACTION

Learners are notified when new resources have been assigned to them by their tutors. Tutors are notified when learners submit work for marking (applicable mainly in English Functional Skills).
