

Personal specification for independent End-point Assessor

Equine Groom

Essential industry specific qualifications and experience

Up-to-date, relevant, and broad experience of working within the specific industry area and the ability to show current knowledge of working practices, legislation and policy within the sector. The applicant must be specifically qualified, with experience in the Equine and Horse industry to meet the specific needs of the standard.

Essential qualifications and experience

Minimum five years' recent experience working in the equestrian industry and the specific occupational route that they will be assessing through the standard

Experience at a higher level (Level 3 or above as a minimum) than the role being assessed so that they understand the context of the role

Current CPD activity, which demonstrates that they are up-to-date with industry specific themes that are relevant to the role covered by the standard

Technical and management expertise to ensure they can assess all areas of the occupational route (s) that they will assess

Must hold, or be working towards an assessor qualification (A1/A2/D32/D33/TAQA or equivalent qualification).

Current experienced Assessors who do not hold a qualification may be able to qualify for this role, before the end of 2020.

An understanding of apprenticeship standards, with specific knowledge about the Equine Groom standard
