


AWARENESS OF OPTIONS

■ 1 - Strongly disagree


■ 2 - Slightly disagree

METHODOLOGY



On behalf of City & Guilds and The Edge Foundation, Edelman Berland conducted online interviews with 1005 Employers in the UK from small, medium and large organisations. The survey was run in September-October 2013.
