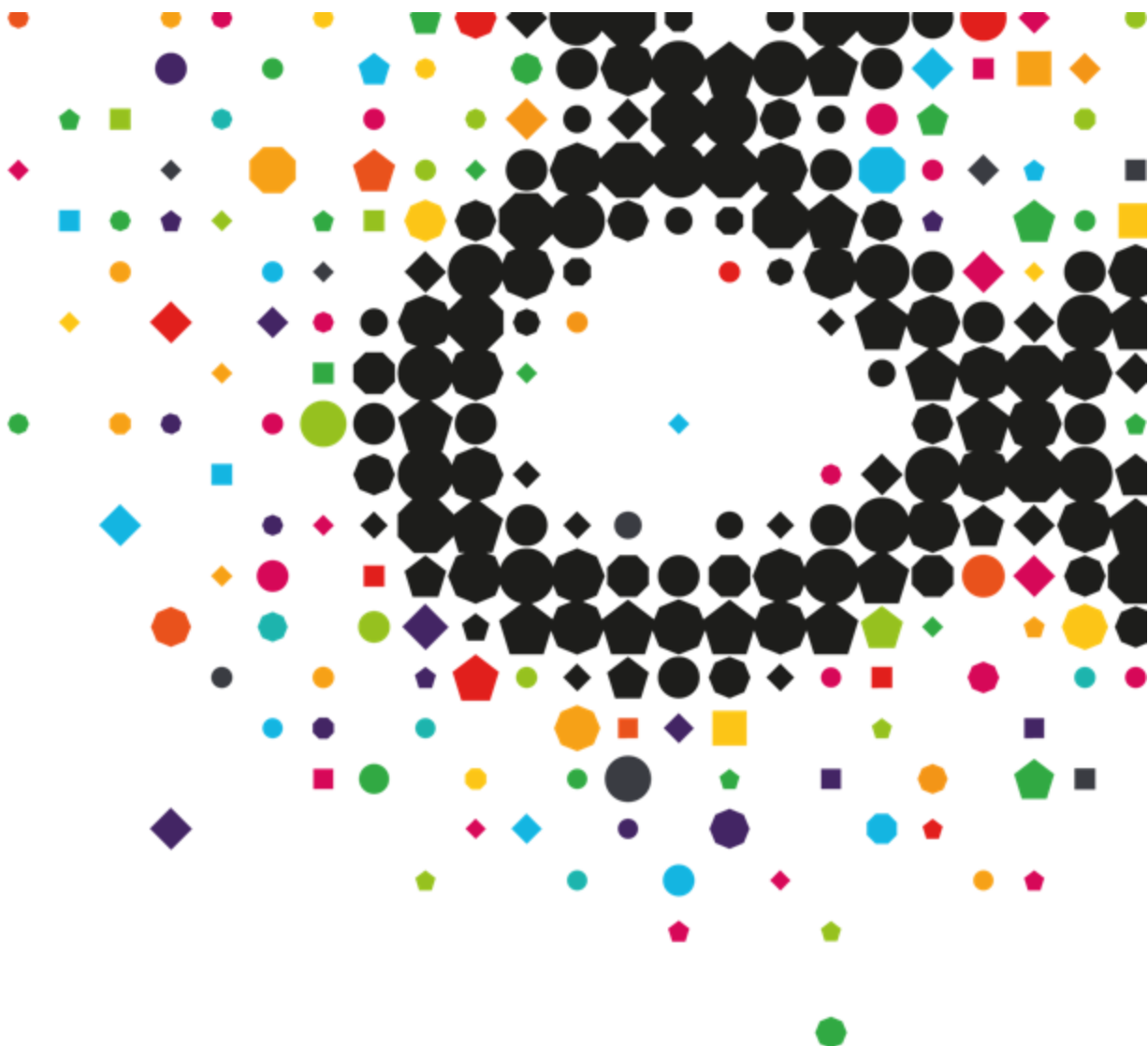

Why is this apprenticeship not ready for delivery?

An apprenticeship standard is only available for delivery when both the standard and assessment plan is approved and a funding band (core government contribution) has been assigned to the standard.

This Apprenticeship does not include a Mandatory qualification, but to support the apprentice with preparing them fully for the EPA City & Guilds has developed an on-programme qualification and support resources that could be used.

The EPA includes:

Funding Rules for Apprenticeships

The ESFA have today published an updated (version 2) of the Funding Rules for Apprenticeships, which include details of the new arrangements for SME/non-levy paying employers to reserve funds for apprenticeship starts and access the Apprenticeship Service to choose their provider (rather than be restricted to a provider who has a non-levy ESFA contract) from Jan to March under the initial pilot (5000 starts per month).

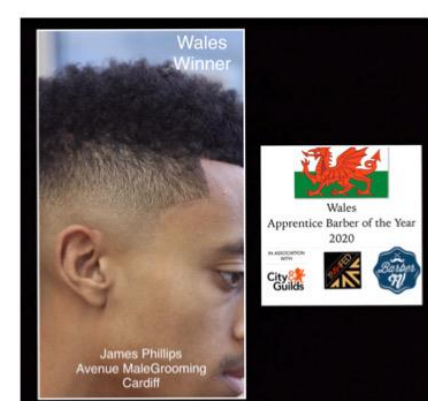

Fantasy Hair and Make-up Team
Time allowed: 90 minutes Can be hair or make-up first
Refer to general rules also on page 9.



Hair time allowed 40 minutes:

1. This event allows the competitor to exercise creativity and imagination for a total look on a **Male or Female model. Costume to be worn to enhance the overall look Judging will be made on the creativity of design**
2. Full freedom of techniques in hair creation, no restriction on theme
3. Any hair additions/ornamentation must be displayed at the start of the competition, 50% of the models own hair must be used in the creation.
4. No electrical equipment can be used.



Make-Up time allowed 40 minutes:

1. No diagrams, photographs to assist are allowed, stencils, transfers, or spray paint not allowed. No cut out sponges allowed.
2. Models must be devoid of make up at the start of the competition. Semi - permanent lashes/make-up/brows/eyeliner/lip liner and make up tape are not allowed. For health and safety reasons coloured contact lenses can be applied prior to the competition
3. If using false eyelashes these must be added during the allocated time.
4. Only Make- up to be used to create the look NO prosthetics or airbrushing, all other makeup products can be used. Glitters, stuck on gems etc. must not cover more than 10% of the face



10 minutes will be given for final dressing and preparation for judging if required by both or either competitor.



Sunday direct entry No. 2 – **11.00 am prompt**
MFED Barbering free style creative designs cut and finish
Time allowed: 45 minutes.
Refer to general rules also on page 9.

1. Competitors to produce a finished look that would be worn by the more adventurous male.
2. No previous visible patterns or shapes allowed.
3. No clipper guards allowed.
4. All patterns and designs are allowed over a full head or partial head (minimum 50%)
5. All styling tools and products allowed.
6. 1 Electric socket per competitor only.

Judges will observe at frequent intervals.
