

Following a review of on-site assessment requirements for qualifications leading to gas safe registration, we are pleased to announce an updated common assessment strategy. The review carried out between assessment organisations and EUSkills has been recently been agreed and accepted by the industry boards to be applied consistently across gas aligned qualifications. The updated strategy considers the flexible working practices of many employers and creates a rigorous yet flexible approach to on site assessment. The changes will come into effect from 1st September 2020 for new entrants with an option for those on programme to transfer if suitable.
