

The Construction Industry Training Board (CITB), in its role as the Issuing Authority for Construction Apprenticeships developed under the Specification of Apprenticeship Standards England (SASE), has taken the decision not to proceed with the planned closure of a number of Apprenticeship frameworks at the end of July 2019. This has been done in response to information received from the Institute of Apprenticeships and Technical Education (IFATE) about the readiness of some end point assessment organisations to deliver certain construction related Apprenticeship Standards.

CITB's primary concerns in taking this decision are to ensure that individual candidates are not disadvantaged and that the end-point assessments delivered ensure a quality outcome for learners and industry.

CITB will continue to work closely with IFATE, employer trailblazer groups, training and end-point assessment organisations to agree a timeline for the closure of each framework as new standards are approved for delivery.

In line with our previous commitments, we will ensure that providers are given at least 6 months notice of any planned closures.

The Education and Skills Funding Agency has stated that all frameworks (where they have not already been closed by Issuing Authorities) will be withdrawn by them 2020 to 2021 academic year, as they expect that employers and providers will have completed the transition by this date.
