Welcome

Welcome back and I hope you all managed to get some down time and well-deserved rest over the summer. We are in an educational period of significant change, with government focus been on A Levels, T Levels and Apprenticeships, however the pathways for full time students is less clear. There are reforms for Level 3 qualifications and the government and department for education are looking for a simpler and redefined route for students who fall outside of the A levels, T Levels, and apprenticeship.

New Level 3 qualifications for 16-19 will be based on employer-led occupational standards, these qualifications will support entry to occupations that are not covered by T Levels. There will also be specialist qualifications which cover specialist areas of a skill and knowledge that go beyond those available in T Level or other competence-based qualification. Adults will have access to occupational entry qualifications for occupations without employer-led standard, but which are still in demand by employers. There will also be access to qualifications focusing on a range of cross-sectional skills, transferable across multiple occupations and specialist qualifications such as Electric vehicle and F Gas etc.

Removal of Funding FY22/23

The ESFA annually review all qualifications and remove funding for Low (Less than 100 registrations within funding year) and No registrations. Please check on the Government website for further details on which qualifications will not be funded from 1st August 2022, the link is below to the latest list.

We are still very active in supporting centres with EPA preparation sessions, which includes EPA task and centre setup along with ensuring the apprentices are prepared technically for the EPA assessment. We also discuss the importance of ensuring apprentices are physically/mentally prepared for their end point assessment, this will help to mitigate the potential stress and manage

Green Skills

One of the Industry sectors most in demand for employees with a specific skill set is the renewable and sustainability energy sector, highlighted with the recent Government Green Skills Agenda.

*City and Guilds has developed new qualifications for Electric/Hybrid Vehicles designed to provide everything from the Level 1 Award in Introduction to Electric and Hybrid Vehicle High Energy Systems (7290-01), which is suitable for new EV customers, vehicle sales personnel, valeters and anyone who may be encountering electric vehicles, moving onto the Level 2 Award in Safe Maintenance of Electric and Hybrid Vehicles (7290-02) and also a new Level 2, the Level 2 Award in Hazard Management of Electric and Hybrid Vehicles (7290-72), suitable for those working in and around broken down or accident damaged vehicles.

Moving onto the higher levels, we have the Level 3 Award in Component Removal and Replacement in Electric and Hybrid Vehicles (7290-03) along with the Level 4 Award in Diagnosis and Rectification of Faults in Electric and Hybrid Vehicles (7290-04).

There are also options to include these qualifications or units within your Full Time Qualification offer if deemed suitable.







Our new (2473) marine qualifications have been developed to be included within the Foundation Phase and the Development Phase of the new Apprenticeship standards for boatbuilders and marine engineers, which will replace the current level 2 and level 3 Marine, Construction, Systems Engineering and Maintenance (Boatbuilding and Marine Engineering) qualifications from current Apprenticeship Frameworks.

Please Note: The Marine 2463 suite of qualifications are now closed for registrations
