T Level Technical Qualifications in Engineering and Manufacturing

City & Guilds and EAL are developing the T Level Technical Qualifications (TQs) in Engineering and Manufacturing, which will be available for first teaching from September 2022 - available in England only.

T Levels are based on the same standards as apprenticeships, designed by employers and approved by the Institute for Apprenticeships and Technical Education.

To ensure the new qualification is fit for purpose and reflects the knowledge and skills learners need to succeed, we are working with employers and industry leaders in the design and development of the technical qualifications.
