## This quarter's highlights



### Provider approval process

**The approval window for September 2023 delivery closed on 30 June.**

For those who have already gained approval during this window, your TQA will be reaching out shortly to arrange your Action Plan review. Please be aware, all actions from your approval report must be signed off in time for September delivery.

You can find the forms on the T Levels Resource Hub, along with the TL-DS form, which should be used in place of CVs for your staff. However, you are still able to submit CVs via the T Level Service Portal should you prefer. If you don't yet have access to the Service Portal, you will receive this shortly after you submit your application form.



Please be aware, your allocated TQA will be in regular communication with you in the 30 working days following your application being submitted, and potentially longer.

## Assessment update



### Summer assessment results

We will make detailed 'Results Slips' available from **Walled Garden** on Wednesday 16 August 2023\*. These will provide raw marks, UMS and grades (where applicable) for those candidates who have completed summer Core assessments.

We will provide the raw mark and grade for this summer's Building Services Engineering and Onsite Construction Occupational Specialism results.

**Results must not be released to candidates until Thursday 17 August 2023.**

\*Results may be delayed where exam scripts and/or candidate evidence has not been returned on time and without issue.

### T Level programme achievement and grading

For any candidates coming to the end of their second/final year, any achieved components outside of the T Level Technical Qualification (e.g., industry placement, maths/English) must have been recorded on the Department for Education's (DfE) '[Manage T Level results](#)' service by 23 June 2023.

City & Guilds does not provide a grade for a candidate's overall T Level programme as we do not have visibility of industry placement nor maths/English achievement. The DfE will make these available to Providers.

The grading look-up tables have been updated by the DfE and will be reflected in each of our T Level TQ specifications. Building Services Engineering and Onsite Construction are available now, and other TQ specifications will be updated shortly.

Providers will be able to determine the final programme grade based on the grades achieved for the Core and Occupational Specialism (OS) by referring to the updated look-up tables in section 6 of the relevant specification.

For candidates taking paired OS (e.g., Plumbing and Heating) an additional look-up table converts two OS grades into one – this can be found in section 6 of the 'Building Services Engineering for Construction' specification.
