As you may be aware City & Guilds in partnership with EAL have secured the contract for developing the new technical qualifications in Construction On-site and Building Engineering Services (BSE) for the T-Level project in England. T Levels will be the new alternative to A levels and Apprenticeships for someone continuing in education and looking for a route into industry or further education within our sector.

We are in the midst of development and we are at the stage where both employer and provider feedback is vital for us to ensure the qualifications are fit for purpose. We are looking to ensure the Technical qualifications we are developing are of the highest standard and a suitable level to ensure suitable progression.

This is where we need your help!

We are looking for employers and representatives from industry as well as college/provider staff to review elements of the draft technical qualifications (we will give you key points to consider) and then answer some questions (probably a survey) relating to key themes we require feedback on.

Due to the Easter break we are looking to get the ball rolling on this towards the end of the month and envisage that the feedback session will last no longer than an hour, with around an hours work prior to the session. This will give us the valued feedback we need from the employers/ representatives and the college/provider network to ensure development is shaped into what the industry requires.

Construction On-site

- Core content (H&S, Science, Design, Communication, Collaboration, Sustainability, the Built Environment, Technologies and Waste Management)
- Bricklaying
- Carpentry & Joinery
- Painting and Decorating
- Plastering
