Booking your assessments

Update: due to essential maintenance, Walled Garden will be unavailable from 18:00 Thursday 14 December until 09:00 Tuesday 19 December. Therefore, we have extended the booking deadline for all assessments to **Friday 22 December**. Centres should now make bookings for the following:

- spring exams
- synoptic assignments
- optional assignments
- any other centre assessed components, if applicable
- employer involvement, if applicable
- *bookings for summer exams will open 1 March 2018.
