What is the content of this qualification?	 The qualification consists of mandatory units. Learners will cover both practical and theoretical aspects of the automotive industry, such as: sector knowledge of the automotive industry factors that influence the design process of a vehicle different manufacturing methods which can be used materials that are used in the construction of a vehicle, their properties and the joining methods used during vehicle manufacture construction and operation of engine, transmission and chassis systems and their components electrical and electronic systems vehicle inspections servicing procedures how technology can be used to improve vehicle design logical thinking skills to diagnose and repair complex vehicle faults how to apply scientific and mathematical principles in vehicle related areas management techniques to develop employees, control and allocate financial resources as well as marketing.
