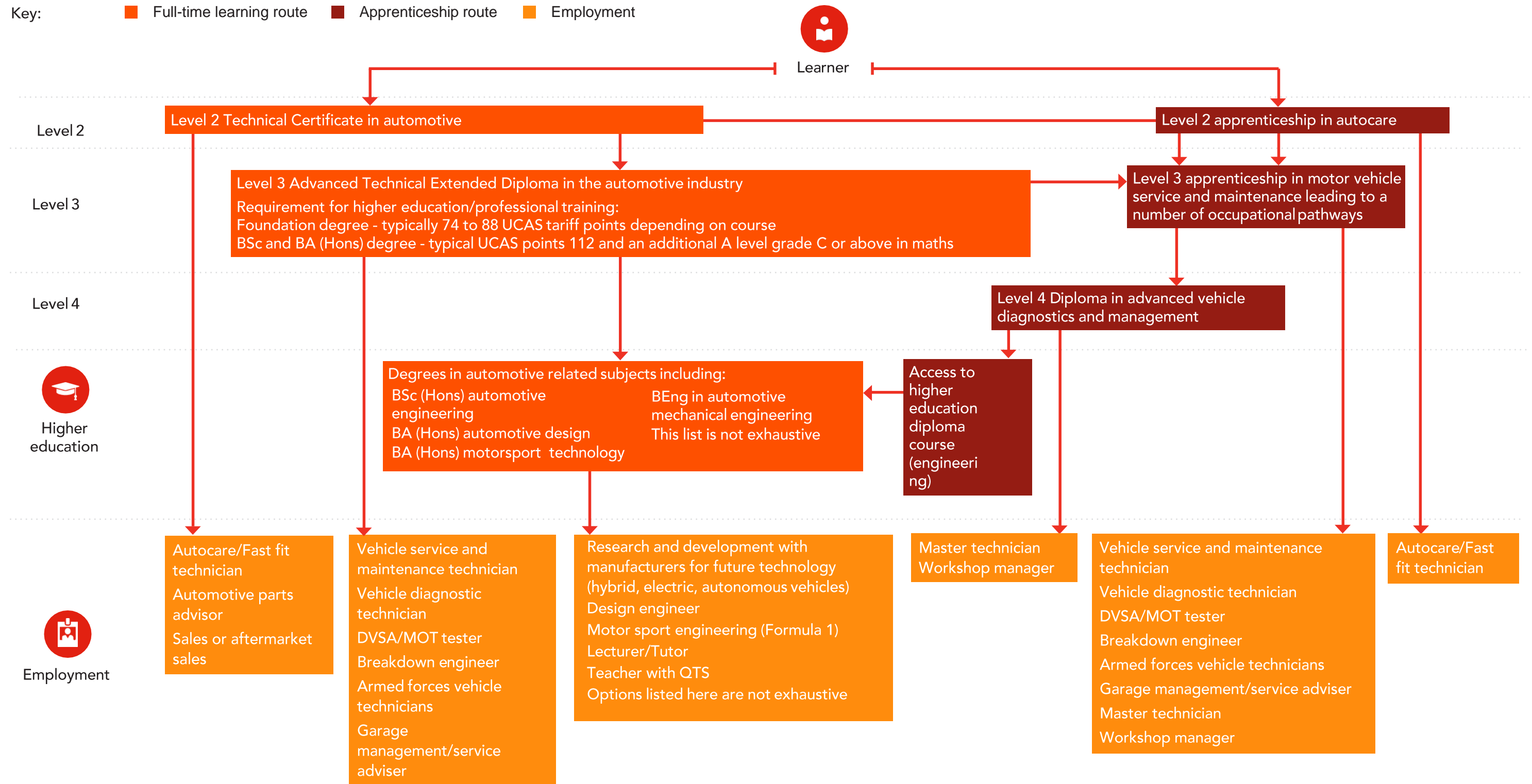


Your career in automotive starts here

Learners can choose between Technical Qualifications and apprenticeships which can progress into meaningful employment or higher education (university).

Requirements: Centres will set their own entry requirements. Typically 4 GCSEs grades C/4 and above including: maths, English and science. Level 1 full-time programmes are available for those not meeting entry requirements. We strongly advise learners to contact their preferred university or college for details on courses and entry requirements.
