




### **Getting the best from Open Assess**

### Bitesized qualifications and units

#### Mathematics Skills and English Skills (3847)

- Collection of small (10-20 hour) units, each of which focuses on a **specific area** of the adult numeracy and literacy national standards.
- 100 units in total (55 maths, 45 English), covering Entry 1 to Level 2
- Each unit is a qualification in its own right; can also be combined into larger 'themed' awards and certificates.
- **Portfolio-assessed** with no externally set assignments or exams.



#### **Principles of Mathematics (3844)**

- Covers substantive parts of the adult numeracy and literacy standards, with a particular focus on receptive skills, knowledge and understanding.
- Assessment through a one-off **on-screen test** available on-demand with instant results.
- Enables learners to demonstrate a solid grasp of the key principles of maths and English, as well as the **resilience** to operate effectively in a test environment.

Available at Entry 3 to Level 2.






### From Flash to HTML

Functional Skills assessments are migrating from Flash to HTML.

There are samples of the new look HTML assessments available in Open Assess now.

All live e-volve Reading, Writing and Mathematics exams at level 1 and level 2 will be in the new HTML format from 15 September 2023 and Flash tests will be switched off

This means there will be **no need** to use Surpass Viewer to take live tests.

### What's new for entry level FS for September 2023?

- There will be a brand-new set of live assessments for Reading, Writing and Mathematics at Entry Level 1, 2 and 3 placed on the website on 3<sup>rd</sup> September 2023.
- These will all have new passwords applied, and these passwords will be available from Walled Garden in the Administration section on the 4748-01 or 4748-03 catalogue pages as appropriate.
- The current versions of the papers will be removed from the website and candidates **must not** sit these assessments on or after 3 September 2023. Any assessments which were taken before this date **can** be marked, internally quality assured and results entry claims submitted.
- We will be asking selected centres to submit their Assessment Tracking document recording the
  assessment titles and marks candidates have sat. It is possible that we will ask for the submission
  of specific assessments.
- An email alert will be going out this week, or next so please share the email with any colleagues involved in the administration or IQA of entry level assessments

### **Digital Functional Skills Qualifications**

City & Guilds' new Digital Functional Skills Qualifications (DFSQs) will be available for first teaching in September 2023.

Available at Entry Level 3 and Level 1, these qualifications will replace the existing Functional Skills ICT qualifications and will be the new funded offer in the digital space at Level 1 and below, alongside Essential Digital Skills qualifications.

### **ESOL Skills for Life**

#### **Claiming Certificates**

- If learners are registered for the single mode awards (4692-01) then from now onwards, as well as claiming the unit they have completed, you will also need to claim a certification code in order to generate a certificate.
- These codes are in the 900 series (i.e. 4692-901 for xxxx)



#### **Remote supervision of ESOL assessments**

- Following feedback from customers we have decided to permit virtual supervision of ESOL SfL assessments, which was used during the Covid adaptations.
- An alert will be issued shortly confirming the details and a guidance document will be placed on the 4692-qualification page to support staff.


