


Welcome to this month's update!

e-volve upgrade

The upgrade of our e-volve SecureAssess platform will take place this month!

Why are we upgrading?

 As Adobe ends its support for the Flash Player on 31 December we are taking the opportunity to move to an upgraded platform.

When is it happening?

- The e-volve upgrade will take place from
 - 18:00 on Tuesday 24 November to 23:59 on Tuesday 1 December 2020.
- Results will continue to be processed on Wednesday 2 December 2020.

What to expect

- Enhanced screen layout to benefit administrators and invigilators
- Administrators will have more control over user set-ups
- Regular improvements and bug fixes with planned updates and timely roll-out
- Fewer unexpected and unplanned flash-based IT issues.



e-volve upgrade


Three important actions centres will need to complete:

- Upload all completed exams and results onto the e-volve platform before the upgrade by 18:00 GMT on Tuesday 24 November 2020 otherwise they will be lost.
- Create new passwords an email will be sent to your centre's e-volve Primary and Technical contacts on Wednesday 2 December 2020, outlining how to reset and create a new password for the upgraded platform.
- Download and install the new e-volve secure client platform detailed instruction on the installation will be sent to the named contacts for your centre a week prior to the upgrade.

Please also note the following:

 Analytics will be unavailable during the upgrade period. However, you can continue to use the same service once the upgrade has been completed

What are they?

Mathematics/English Skills (3847)

- Collection of small (10-20 hour) units, each of which focuses on a specific area of the adult numeracy and literacy national standards.
- 100 units in total (55 maths, 45 English), covering Entry 1 to Level 2
- Each unit is a qualification in its own right; can also be combined into larger 'themed' awards and certificates.
- Portfolio-assessed with no externally set assignments or exams.

Principles of Mathematics/English (3844)

- Covers substantive parts of the adult numeracy and literacy standards, with a particular focus on receptive skills, knowledge and understanding.
- Assessment through a one-off onscreen test – available on-demand with instant results.
- Enables learners to demonstrate a solid grasp of the key principles of maths and English, as well as the resilience to operate effectively in a test environment.
- Available at **Entry 3** to **Level 2**.

Portfolio building, some tips...

Think holistically	Evidence will often meet more than one purpose/unit eg a piece of free writing might demonstrate both coherent structure and appropriate use of SPaG (as well as indicating the candidate has read and understood a piece of stimulus material).
Check range requirements	Most of these units' criteria need to be met on at least two occasions make sure candidates have opportunity to do this.
Clear referencing is essential	Assessment decisions must be transparent and auditable location of evidence for each criterion/occasion needs to be clear (and easily understandable).
Authentication and sign-off	Candidate and assessor both need to sign-off unit once complete doesn't necessarily have to be 'wet' signature.



What these qualifications aren't...

They're not trying to 'compete' with Functional Skills or GCSE

 but could be used to support progress towards either/both of these.

They're not a 'clever ruse' to get more or duplicate funding

 although there are circumstances where they may attract funding and/or help meet funding conditions.

They're not necessary or appropriate for everyone

 but they're also not just for SEND learners.

They're intended to support and recognise learners' achievements

 but not to create extra work for its own sake.



Funding rules, within England

There are circumstances where these units and qualifications can attract Adult Education Budget funding.

Also, some of the Entry level Mathematics/English Skills qualifications can be counted directly towards the 16-18 Condition of Funding.
