





11 May 2021	Last booking date for paper-based L1 and L2 Reading, Writing & Maths assessments
28 May 2021	Last date that on-screen OR paper-based L1 and L2 assessments can be taken
4 June 2021	All completed assessment scripts must be received by City & Guilds by this date
18 June 2021	Last date for Entry Level assessments or SLC assessments to be taken
30 June 2021	All Internal and External Quality Assurance Activity must be complete
16 July 2021	All claims for certification for Entry Level Maths and English and L1/2 English must be made by this date
31 July 2021	Last certification date

Remote assessment of Functional Skills SLC assessments

- Introduced during the adaptations for Covid-19, this flexibility will continue to be available to assess learners for the Speaking, Listening & Communicating component.
- Each FS English level has an Assessors' guide which outlines the requirements and gives advice about carrying out this assessment

Remote invigilation of Level 1 & 2 Functional Skills Reading, Writing and Mathematics exams

We're currently working with a small number of customers on developing a remote invigilation solution for Functional Skills. We hope to be able to roll this out within the next few months.




Updates to ICE requirements for Functional Skills

An Updated ICE document now available – Covid-19 adaptations

include:

- Increased flexibility about when centres have to notify City & Guilds about changes of exam dates/times
- Exam dates can be changed for an individual candidate without changing the whole cohort
- City & Guilds do not need to be informed of exam locations before exams take place
- Additional guidance around access arrangements with scribes and readers during social distancing
- Guidance around safe distribution and collection of papers and quarantine of papers before returning them to City & Guilds





Planned change for Functional Skills Maths onscreen – Winter 2020

We are planning a change to the rules around the use of the candidates own calculator in onscreen Level 1 and 2 Functional Skills Maths exams.

Candidates will be able to use their own calculator in the e-volve exam.

There will be a break in between the two sections, which can be used to distribute calculators. If the candidate is using the on-screen calculator, they can skip this break

The requirements will be as follow:

- one invigilator for every 10 candidates,
- candidates must not have access to a calculator during Section 1,
- the invigilator(s) can hand out calculators to candidates that have completed Section 1,
- the invigilator(s) must instruct candidates to raise their hand when they have completed Section 1, so the invigilator can give them a calculator.





Covid-19 adaptations

- Our assessment model is already quite flexible, for example:
 - on-demand availability
 - documents on website
 - centre-assessed.
- Working on some specific guidance, for example
 - to support carrying out Speaking & Listening remotely.

Maths and English within apprenticeships - update



'Study and take the test' rule suspended until 31 March 2021



Prior qualifications list updated

- Apprentices still need to have achieved M&E qualifications at Level 1
- Temporary flexibility for apprentices due to take their EPA up to 31/03/2021 can pass through the gateway without the need to attempt the Level 2 assessment for FS

 ESFA publishes list of M&E qualifications accepted in lieu of Functional Skills or GCSE if achieved prior to starting apprenticeship.






Traineeships

Traineeships are an education and training programme created to help learners who are interested in securing an apprenticeship, or employment.

To support the economic recovery from Covid-19 the UK government announced further funding opportunities for 16-24 year-old-learners in traineeships. They pledge to provide 30,000 new traineeships to get young people in England into work.

- Intended to supplement recorded presentations, but in an environment where it's ok to ask 'daft questions'!




Live update/Q&A sessions
