


Welcome to this month's update!

If you are experiencing issues with the sound but can see the slides, try exiting the webinar and then re-joining – this **usually** solves the problem.











Testing is still available - Functional Skills, ESOL & Principles of • Maths and English

Live Assessments are still available for booking and delivery in the usual way:

- For Functional Skills there are some increased flexibilities around managing the paperdelivered tests – outlined in the <u>Instructions for Conducting Exams</u> guidance available from the 4849 qualification page
- ESOL Skills for Life Assessments continue to be available from the 4692 Qualification page and the Reading exams at Level 1 and 2 can be booked through Walled Garden in the usual way for face to face delivery
- Assessments for Principles for Using Mathematical Techniques and Principles for Using Written and Spoken English (3844) can be booked through Walled Garden for face to face assessment sessions as usual









Functional Skills exams - testing is still available

Test at Home

- Interim solution now available for
 - Level 1 & 2 FS English (Reading and Writing)
 - Level 1 & 2 FS Mathematics
- Approval process applies
 - see <u>Remote Testing</u> pages for details.

NB: Test at Home **not** possible for FS ICT or entry level FS.

Test at Home is also available for ESOL Reading at Levels 1&2 and Principles of Maths and English (3844)

Test centres

- Exams accommodated/invigilated by City & Guilds
 - additional £25 fee applies, per exam.
- Includes paper and on-screen delivery
 - and FS ICT.
- Three venues currently in use

Assessment arrangements for 2020/21

Following the DfE and Ofqual consultation, on 25 February DfE and Ofqual shared the outcomes published in 'Alternative arrangements for the award of VTQs and other general qualifications in 2021'

- The awarding of qualifications in the period 1 August 2020 to 31 August 2021 will be governed by the Vocational Contingency Regulatory Framework (VCRF)
- This allows for qualifications to be taken as normal, or with agreed adaptations and where necessary using alternative arrangements – Teacher Assessed Grades or TAGs

Let's look at the difference ...

CAG process 2020

- Blanket approach for all learners
- No live testing CAGs for everyone
- Making a forecast of a candidate's likely performance by 31 July 2020



Arrangements for 2021

Test is best

- Test as usual
- RI
- Test Centres

Delay where possible

 Where no impact on learner progression

Final option

- Centres will have to apply to be able to submit TAGs
- Only for learners who cannot access a test (as above)
- Alternative arrangement Teacher Assessed Grade
- When the candidate is ready for assessment using the evidence to make a judgement




What next?

- We are developing Teacher guidance to assist teachers and tutors to understand what evidence can be used to support judgements for a TAG
- The process for centres to indicate that they are planning to use the TAG submission process for specific learners is being drawn up
- We are developing the system to enable centres to submit TAGs for eligible learners and are working to make these:
 - practical, manageable and do not create unnecessary burden,
 - maintain the integrity of our qualifications,
 - support valid and reliable results, and
 - do not advantage or disadvantage any one learner over another.
