


Welcome to this month's update!

If you are experiencing issues with the sound but can see the slides, try exiting the webinar and then re-joining – this **usually** solves the problem.







Test at Home

- Interim solution now available for
 - Level 1 & 2 FS English (Reading and Writing)
 - Level 1 & 2 FS Mathematics
- Approval process applies
 - see <u>Remote Testing</u> pages for details.

NB: Test at Home **not** possible for FS ICT or entry level FS.

Test centres

- Exams accommodated/invigilated by City & Guilds
 - additional £25 fee applies, per exam.
- Includes paper and on-screen delivery
 - and FS ICT.
- Three venues currently in use

 - Birmingham
 - Bristol


Sample on-screen tests - update

We now have a solution that enables on-screen tests to be accessed via qualification webpages

- Involves using SurpassViewer application see instructions alongside
- Tests available for the following:
 - Functional Skills (including navigation tests for FS Mathematics)
 - ESOL SfL (L1-2 Reading)
 - Principles of Mathematics/English

OpenAssess remains unavailable for now

- Still possible to open user portal and see test results, but not to take or mark tests.
- We are working on a resolution.


Out of the habit of assessing

Evidence might demonstrate more than one thing – think holistically

Being fair to all learners



Standardisation








Think holistically	Evidence will often meet more than one purpose/unit For example, a piece of free writing might demonstrate both coherent structure and appropriate use of SPaG (as well as indicating the candidate has read and understood a piece of stimulus material).
Check range requirements	Most of these units' criteria need to be met on at least two occasions make sure candidates have opportunity to do this.
Clear referencing is essential	Assessment decisions must be transparent and auditable location of evidence for each criterion/occasion needs to be clear (and easily understandable).
Authentication and sign-off	Candidate and assessor both need to sign-off unit once complete can be a 'virtual' signature.


