

If you are experiencing issues with the sound but can see the slides, try exiting the webinar and then re-joining – this **usually** solves the problem.




Monthly #CGMathsEnglish webinars





Great Jobs: recognising the essential jobs that keep the UK working

Report commissioned to consider challenges facing sectors most impacted by essential worker shortages

The results journey – paper (Named on Demand)





Enter for exam

Date/time is specified when booking; must be at least 14 calendar days ahead.



Materials dispatched

Will normally arrive at least five working days before exam date.




Materials received

Check details are correct; do not open sealed packs, store securely until use.




Pack and post materials

Must be done promptly, with all materials (incl. unused papers) returned in one bag.



Candidates complete exam

Again, ensure all candidates receive correct version; no substitutions or additions!



Opening the packs

Attach bar codes to papers; always ensure candidates given their allocated version.



Scripts received/scanned

Clock starts ticking on results turnaround SLA at this point.



Scripts loaded onto portal

Goes into a queuing system.



Marker downloads/marks

Marking decisions recorded on portal.



Notification/certification

Paper notification (if centre opts in); certificates and credentials (where due).



Results released

Individual candidates' results appear on Walled Garden as they're confirmed.



Marking quality assurance

Ongoing standardisation of each examiner, seeding, sampling and borderlining.



The results journey – on-screen (e-volve)





Schedule exam

Date/time specified when booking; min 30 minutes' notice (longer for RI Service).



Version assigned

Happens on a per-candidate basis (excluding any they've had before).




Set up exam

Use invigilator screen (or printed invigilator pack).



Candidate closes/submits

Uploads immediately if online; otherwise next time device connected.



Candidate completes exam

Must be named candidate; no substitutions allowed.



Unlock test

Exam released to candidate: entry fee triggered at this point.



Script received on portal

Clock starts ticking on results turnaround SLA at this point; goes into queuing system.



Marker logs in and marks

Marking decisions recorded on portal.



Provisional result available

Accessed via e-volve Score Report (might be subject to change).



lotification/certification

Paper notification (if centre opts in); certificates and credentials (where due).



Results released

Individual candidates' results appear on Walled Garden as they're confirmed.



Marking quality assurance

Ongoing standardisation of each examiner, seeding, sampling and borderlining.



Certificates, e-Certificates and Credentials...

Once candidates have achieved a whole Functional Skills qualification (eg all three components of FS English), they are entitled to:

Printed certificate

- confirmation of achievement
- displays Qualification Number (QN) and Ofqual logo
- posted to centre.

e-Certificate

- secure/verifiable PDF of certificate
- issued instead of (or as well as) printed certificate
- extracted from Walled Garden by centre.

Digital credential

- issued in addition to qualification certificate, but easier to share on social media channels and elsewhere
- Open Badge Standard metadata contains summary of relevant Functional Skills subject content.
- issued directly to candidate (if centre has supplied their email address).







Candidate performance feedback

Remember, we provide candidate performance feedback for both on-screen and paper exams

- Both can be accessed via Centre Analytics
- Information presented slightly differently in each case
 - on-screen displays percentage of available marks for each SCS
 - paper uses a series of performance codes
 - both also include an overall score (expressed as percentage for on-screen, as a mark for paper).
- Note on-screen performance data is provisional
 - it's extracted from the e-volve system before final quality/borderline checks have been completed.
