

Start your career with a Traineeship from City & Guilds

Traineeships are an education and training programme created to help learners who are interested in securing an apprenticeship or employment.

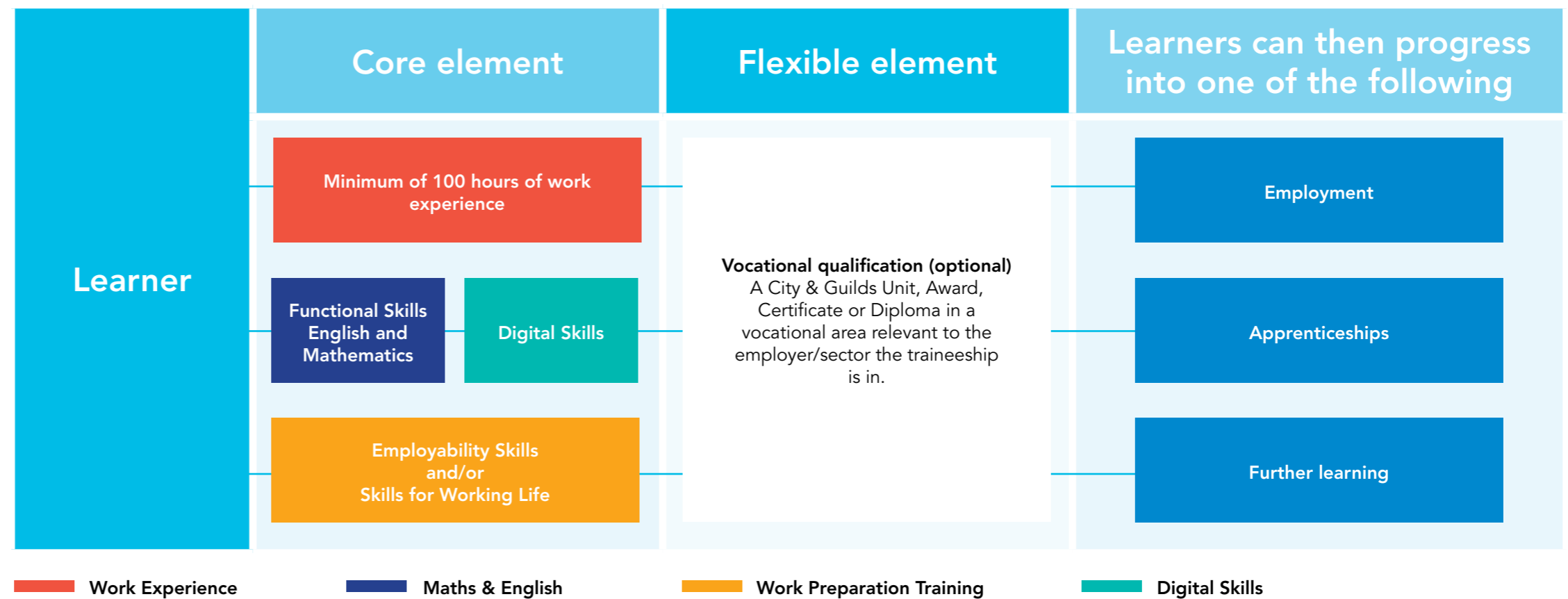
Designed for young people:

- who are not currently in a job and have little or no work experience, but are focused on gaining employment
- aged 16 to 19-years old as study programme provision
- aged 16 to 24-years old and qualified at Level 3 or below
- whom providers and employers believe have a reasonable chance of being ready for employment or higher level training after the traineeship.

The Education and Skills Funding Agency (ESFA) fund traineeships for learners aged between 16-18 and 19-24 as follows:

- 16-18 learners are available through providers/centres who have a contract/grant funding agreement
- 19-24 learners through the adult education budget (AEB) funding. The single work-placement and work-preparation rate is £1500.

Requirement: Centres must be delivering a traineeship for a minimum duration of 6 weeks and a maximum duration of 12 months
