




Welcome!



Specific changes to Functional Skills in response to COVID-19

Changes we've introduced

- All EQA activity now remote, and exam audits suspended.
- Exams may take place up to 10 working days either side of scheduled date/time
 - with no need to complete the exam change notification form.
- Guidance produced for conducting SLC assessments remotely.
- Exams are still available
 - both on-screen and paper.

Changes mandated by DfE and Ofqual

- Functional Skills specifically mentioned in Ministerial Direction to Ofqual on 9 April about technical and vocational qualifications:
 - "learners due to take assessments for Functional Skills Qualifications before the end of the summer [should], receive a calculated result rather than an adapted or postponed assessment".
- What this means in practice currently being worked through
 - with Ofqual and other Functional Skills awarding organisations.

Specific changes to Essential Skills qualifications

Essential Skills Wales (3868)


- Qualifications Wales has announced a temporary change to the assessment requirements for Essential Skills:
 - learners due to complete before 31 July will be able to receive a 'calculated result'
 - further relaxations (eg no requirement to complete confirmatory test) will also apply until November.

Essential Skills Northern Ireland (4800)

 Department for the Economy (DfE) is currently reviewing a range of possible options for Essential Skills, in consultation with providers, awarding organisations and CCEA Regulation.

Potential changes to other maths/English/ESOL qualifications

'Bite-sized' qualifications – eg English Skills and Mathematics Skills (3847)

- The 3847 suite, especially, is portfolio assessed – so in any event can be completed quite flexibly.
- We'll advise if there are any further specific regulatory changes.

ESOL Skills for Life (4692)

- These qualifications are potentially in-scope for adapted assessment arrangements – so watch this space.
- We've in any case published outline guidance for conducting speaking and listening remotely.

Essential Digital Skills

- A new set of Digital Skills standards have been developed for England, setting out a range of skills, attitudes and behaviours adults need in order to safely benefit from, participate in and contribute to the digital world.
- Essential Digital Skills qualifications will be available at Entry 3 and Level 1, with 'legal entitlement' status within the Adult Education Budget.
- We're <u>consulting on what our EDS</u> <u>qualifications might look like</u>.
