

Our new #CGMathsEnglish webinar updates provide **two** opportunities amonth for maths and English part of an update and Q&A.


Depending on your preferred timeslot, you can sign up for any of the following

## These sessions are for practitioners or managers who are:






#### Connect~Share~Network

Facilitated small-group sessions for practitioners to network and share insights/experiences (**not** a training session).


- Various Functional Skills sessions, focusing on:


