




Welcome to this month's update!

- Don't forget to sign up for our <u>email alerts</u> too!










Face-to-face support won't be happening for some time

- What can we do remotely?
- How can we keep you up-to-date?

Here's a few ideas...

Networks

- Small group sessions (eg no more than 20).
- Always with a clear theme and focus,
- Emphasis on practitioners bringing and sharing ideas.

TeachMeets

- Series of short presentations from practitioners.
- Usually an over-arching theme.
- All about sharing ideas.

Recorded presentations

- Either video or slides with a voiceover.
- Information sharing (eg about particular City & Guilds products and services, or a specific initiative/development).

Intro/update sessions

- Intended for new staff/centres (or new to City & Guilds).
- Intended to supplement recorded presentations, but in an environment where it's ok to ask 'daft questions'!

Live Q&A sessions

- A chance to ask questions, confirm understanding, myth-bust.
- Usually with a theme and focus – but wouldn't have to be.
- Should these have a regular timeslot?

A podcast?

- Just an idea but would you subscribe if we did?
- Format? Interviews, guests, discussion...?
- How often?
