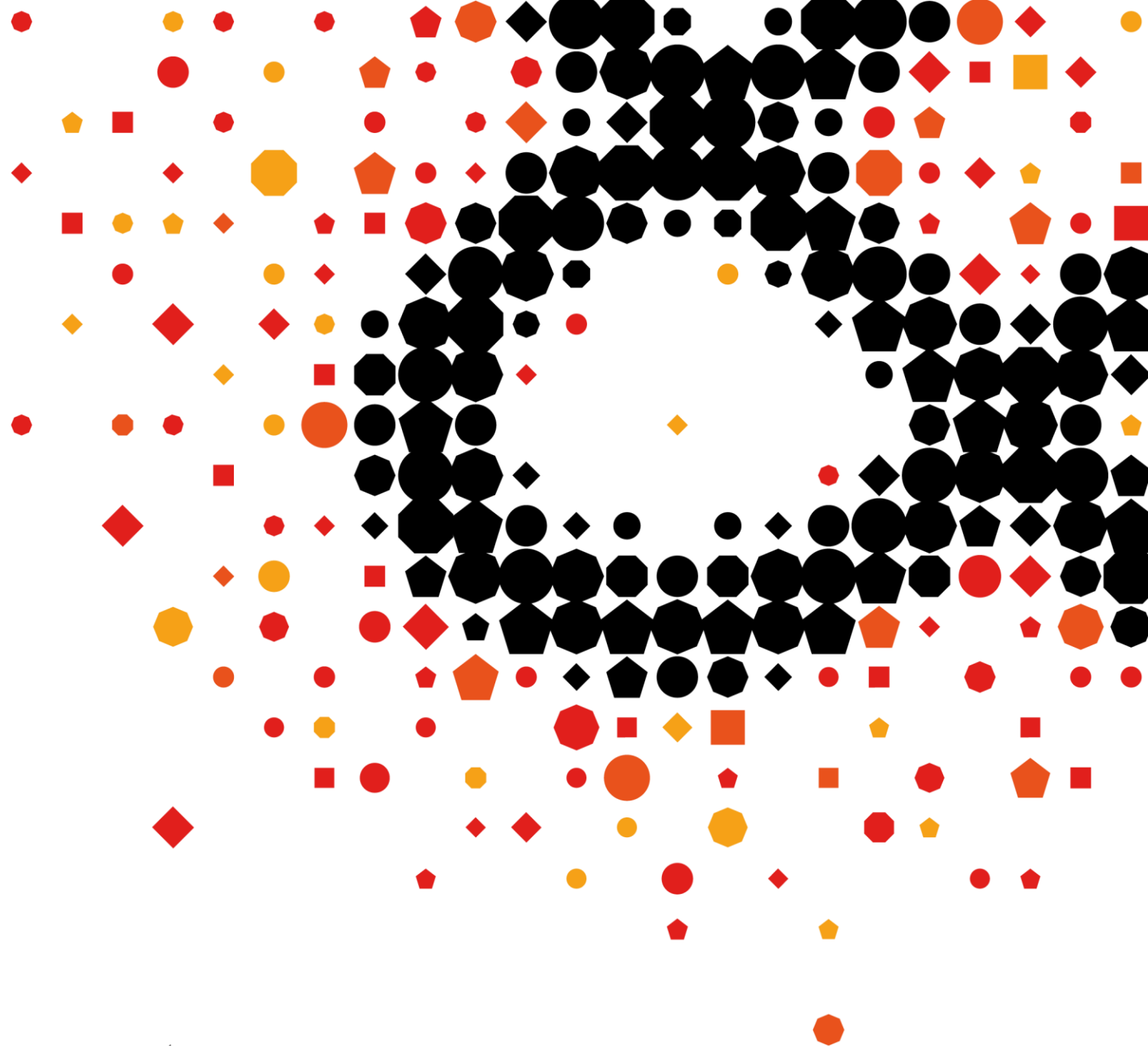

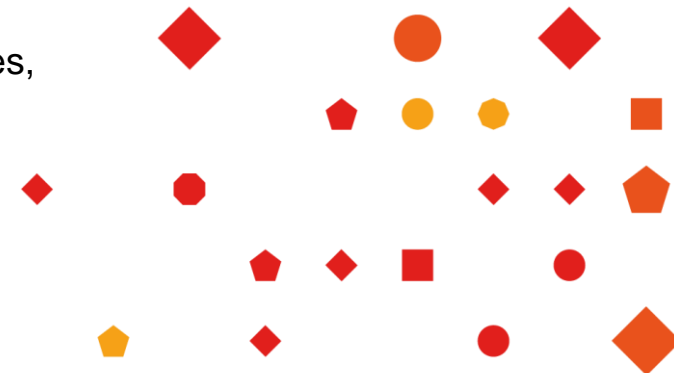
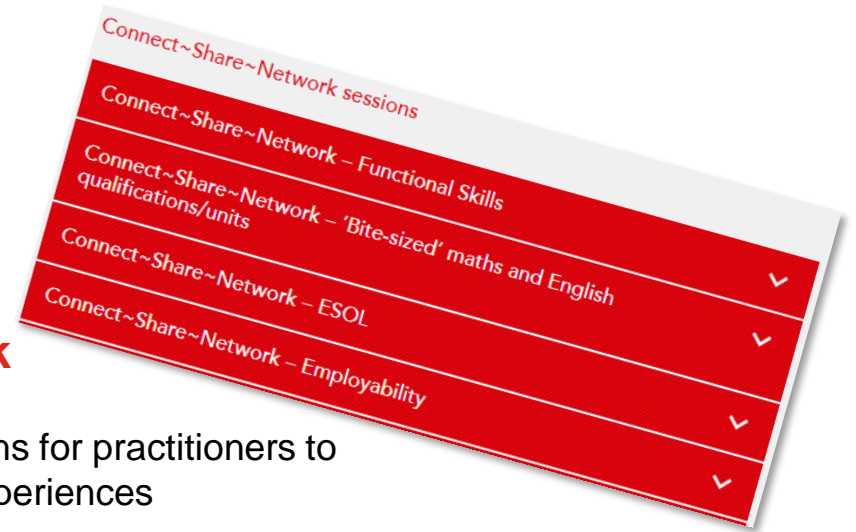
TAG no more!

- Contingency regulatory framework remains in place, but **all** Functional Skills learners expected to complete exams/assessments.
- Some adaptations remain, eg:
 - remote invigilation for Level 1-2 exams (although interim 'test at home' system has now been replaced by a new [Remote Invigilation Service](#))
 - remote assessment for Entry level.

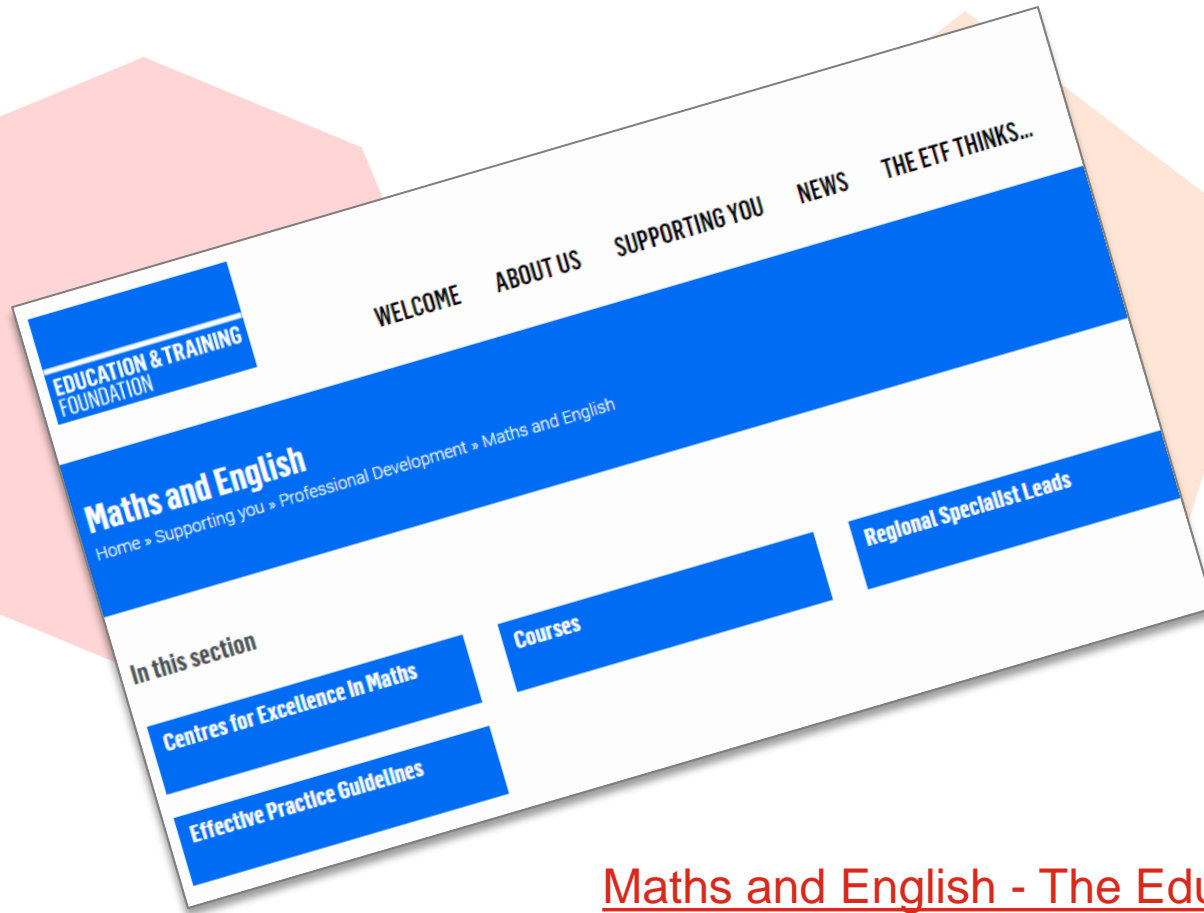

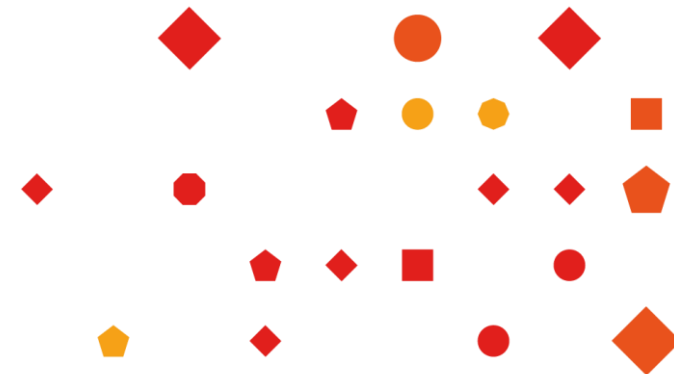
