

Hairdressing

These qualifications are for those interested in a career in hairdressing.

Covering everything from shampooing, styling and dressing to cutting, colouring, and barbering. With flexible entry points, learners don't need a current salon placement to get started, making these qualifications accessible to both beginners and those with experience.

Progression at every level:

- Level 1: Ideal for beginners as an introductory qualification that focuses on foundational skills for aspiring salon assistants, learning basic techniques such as blowdrying and styling hair, consultation and an introduction to basic colour techniques.
- Level 2: Perfect for learners starting out or working under supervision. Builds solid foundations in core hairdressing skills, suitable for both young learners (14–16) and adults.
- Level 3: Designed for those with salon experience who want to advance or specialise, whether in women's hairdressing, barbering, or colouring.
- Level 4: For experienced professionals aiming to refine expertise and broaden career opportunities.

Flexible learning, tailored to learners.

Depending on whether learners choose an award, certificate, or diploma, they'll complete a mix of core and optional units, giving them the freedom to focus on the skills most relevant to their goals.

Creative hair and beauty studies
















Digital credentials


