Delivery

Level 2 Foundation Apprenticeship in Onsite Trades (FA0003)

Typical duration to gateway:
8 months | Funding: £4,000

Gateway-to-completion requirements:

- Online multiple choice test
- Portfolio of evidence
- Apprentices must follow the English and maths formal qualification requirements as set out in the Department for Education Apprenticeship funding rules.
- Employer confirmation that the apprentice has suitably demonstrated the Employability Skills and Behaviour (EB) statements over the course of the Foundation Apprenticeship



Assessment methods

Knowledge test: a selection of MCQs that are drawn from across the various Assessment Outcomes within the assessment plan.

- This assessment should take place when the apprentice is ready.
- Pass/fail.
- Health and safety related MCQs will support the apprentices knowledge in preparation for CSCS test requirements.



Portfolio of evidence

- Can include: Annotated photos, videos, workplace records and reflective accounts.
- Covers AO1, AO2 & AO3 of the assessment plan
- Internally assessed, externally quality assured



Certification

Successful learners receive a City & Guilds Level 2 Onsite trades foundation apprenticeship certificate, plus a digital credential to showcase and verify their skills online, helping them stand out to employers and customers.


