Grace has booked into the salon for two appointments. The first, a week before the interview for a three hour appointment and the second on the morning of the interview for a two

hour appointment.

Physical

Observations: Skin analysis: dehydrated cheek area with fine texture,

blocked pores on the nose and a few papules on the chin Hand and nail condition: cuticles dry and overgrown,

nails jagged, short and bitten.

Foot and nail condition: dry skin on heels, nails strong and ridged.

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
