Level 3 Award in the In-Service Inspection and Testing of Electrical Equipment FAQs

When will the new 5th Edition IET Code of Practice for In Service Inspection & Testing be published?

The publication is available to purchase through the IET website and other vendors.

When will the new 2377-77 qualification be live and available for registrations?

The qualification is now live and open for registrations.

When will the old 2377 complexes (22 & 32) expire for registrations & certifications?

We are looking to expire both old complexes (22 & 32) on our systems by February 28th 2021. Certifications will expire February 28th, 2022

Are the 2377-22 & 32 complexes aligned to the 5th Edition Code of Practice?

No – this complex has not been updated. Centres wishing to have learners go through the 5^{th} Edition should register them on 2377-77.

What support resources will you have to offer?

We will have some E-Learning materials to purchase through our SmartScreen platform. E-Learning materials will be available by the end of November 2020.

We will also have some sample questions which will be downloadable (password protected from our 2377 web page). This will consist of a 20 item MCQ paper.

What is the assessment structure of 2377-77?

To successfully complete the qualification learners will have to sit an Evolve on-line test comprising of a 50 MCQ and a practical assignment. The practical consists of 3 tasks which are:

Task 1 is inspect and test Class I equipment,

Task 2 is inspect and test Class II equipment (this will be either unearthed metal or without unearthed metal or Class II FE – Learners will not need to do all 3 of these, they only need to do one type),

Task 3 is completing the record forms

What is the Qualification Accreditation Number?

603/6790/8

Will you be launching a Digital Credential for 2377-77?

Yes, we will be. Centres are required to add learners email addresses at the point of registering their candidates through Walled Garden. Without a valid learner email address, a credential will not be issued upon successful completion.

Where can I find the Test Specification to see the weightings of the questions for the MCQ?

This can be found within the course handbook.

Is the new 2377-77 automatic approval?

Centres who have previously been delivering 2377-22 & 32 will receive automatic approval to run the new complex. Any centres who haven't been will need to go through the normal approval process. Details of which can be found on our website.

Is the new assessment open or closed book?

2377-77 will be open book. Permitted reference materials will be IET Code of Practice for inservice Inspection and Testing of Electrical Equipment. The use of a programmable calculator is allowed.
