OVERVIEW

What does this qualification cover?

This qualification is for candidates who work or wish to work in the Electrotechnical industry. The qualification aims to provide expert guidance to learners wishing to gain knowledge and understanding of electrical installations within dwellings. This qualification is primarily aimed at electrical installers, wishing to progress further in employment. On successful completion candidates will become eligible and recognised by certification bodies, as competent to undertake electrical work. This will be the minimum qualification level for Qualified Supervisors responsible for electrical work in domestic properties subject to Part P of the Building Regulations (England and Wales).

All learners will complete the mandatory units within the qualification learners will need to undertake the following units;

- Understand and apply health and safety legislation, practices and procedures 'electrical installations in dwellings'
- Understand and apply environmental legislation, working practices and the principles of environmental technology systems associated with electrical installations in dwellings
- Understand and apply the practices and procedures for overseeing and organising the work environment when installing electrical installations in dwellings
- Electrotechnical occupational competence - approval of electrical installations in dwellings
- Understanding and applying the principles, practices and procedures for the planning, preparation and selection of wiring systems and electrotechnical equipment in dwellings
- Understand and apply the principles, practices and legislation for diagnosing and correcting electrical faults in electrical installations in dwellings
- Understand and apply the practices and procedures for the installation and connection of wiring systems and electrotechnical equipment in dwellings
- Understand and apply the principles, practices and legislation for the inspection, testing, commissioning, approving and certification of electrical installations in dwellings

This is a Framework qualification.



Who could take this qualification? OR who is this qualification designed for?

This is a standalone qualification, and is suitable for anyone aged 18 and over.

The Level 3 certificate is ideal if you've worked in the industry for and have some level of experience some time, and you want to develop your skills further and become a qualified supervisor within the Electrotechnical sector. This qualification is aimed and designed for adult learners.

WHAT COULD THIS QUALIFICATION LEAD TO?

On successful completion the qualification reflects the minimum technical competencies required, to become a registered qualified supervisor as of April 6th 2013. It will enable learners to learn, develop and practise the skills required for employment and/or career progression in the electrotechnical sector.
