OVERVIEW

What does this qualification cover?

This qualification covers the intermediate practical skills and knowledge required to work in facilities roles within the facilities industry either in a cleaning, ground maintenance or site maintenance role.

You will take the following mandatory units

- Reduce risks to health and safety in the workplace
- Promote and maintain service delivery
- Contribute to the effectiveness and efficiency of premises and facilities
- Develop customer relationships

And then select from the following optional units, depending on your job role within facilities services

- Support the work of a team and develop yourself
- Control the use of resources in a property, caretaking and facilities services environment
- Maintain grounds of premises and facilities
- Maintain site security and safety
- Control the use of premises and facilities
- Work safely at heights
- Monitor and maintain electrical and plumbing services
- Carry out maintenance and minor repairs
- Operate plant to maintain the quality of pool water
- Deal with routine waste
- Deal with non-routine waste
- Deep clean equipment in premises and facilities
- Handle mail
- Support the co-ordination of an event









- Moving and transporting individuals within a healthcare environment
- Provide reception services
- Clean and maintain internal surfaces and areas
- Introduction to equality and inclusion in health, social care or children's and young people's settings
- Transport physical resources within the work area

This is a Framework qualification.

Who could take this qualification?

This qualification is suitable if you wish to pursue a career in facilities management roles within the facilities industry. Ideally you should already have completed the Level 1 Certificate in Introduction to the Facilities Industry (600/2938/9) qualification or have a basic understanding of facilities services operations.

You need to be 16 years old or over to take this qualification. You need to be employed in a facilities services role in order that you can gather the evidence from the workplace to go towards your portfolio of evidence.
