Level 2 Certificate in practical cleaning skills (601/4264/9)

OVERVIEW

What does this qualification cover?

It covers the skills and knowledge associated with advanced cleaning operations.

The learner will take the mandatory 'Preparing to work in the cleaning industry' unit and will then select another four units out of a possible ten units depending on their chosen specialism. This can include both internal and external cleaning, floor and carpet cleaning and green cleaning. There is the opportunity to demonstrate management skills by choosing one of the level 3 units in the 'Training of cleaning operatives' or 'Introduction to team leading' units.

This is a Framework qualification.

Who could take this qualification?

This qualification is designed for those who have been working within the cleaning industry for a short while, possess some basic cleaning skills and knowledge and who want to progress further within the industry by learning more advanced cleaning skills with a view to becoming a supervisor.

This qualification is suitable for learners aged 16 and over.

WHAT COULD THIS QUALIFICATION LEAD TO?

It could lead to a variety of cleaning roles including

- Cleaning training supervisor
- Cleaning audit specialist
- Specialist flooring and carpet cleaner
- Cleaning supervisor or team leader
- Bio hazard cleaning operative

The learner could progress onto an intermediate apprenticeship in cleaning and environmental support services or intermediate apprenticeship in Facilities Services or other qualification such as
