- Networking, telephony and VoIP (4 credits).

HOW IS THE QUALIFICATION DELIVERED AND ASSESSED?

Learners should be taught in a classroom environment and assessed through a set of City & Guilds assignments or via a CompTIA DHTI+ test

If they are following the whole course, they can be assessed by either CompTIA's DHTI+ test or City & Guilds assignment. If they are taking the course, then they will be assessed through City & Guilds assignments.
