# What does this qualification cover?

The Level 2 Certificate in Software Development has been created to support the growing activity in learning coding and acts as an introduction to software development that can lead to further learning for those wishing to become professional developers in the software, applications and games industries.

Learners are required to complete a mandatory unit;

Principles of designing and creating software

and select a programming and other units that will help them develop their software skills, in subjects that include;

- Creating an object orientated computer program
- Creating an event driven computer program
- Creating a procedural computer program
- Business concepts
- Data representation and manipulation for IT
- Software testing
- Web fundamentals
- Customer support provision
- Website software
- Database software
- Software design fundamentals

This is a Framework qualification.

## Who could take this qualification?

The Level 2 Certificate for Software Developers is aimed at those who want to work in a software development environment and provides some key skills and practice that allow the learner to gain experience to progress to further learning or employment as part of an Apprenticeship, as well as those in employment looking for a change of career or certificating their ability.

No previous experience or qualifications in ICT are expected and the qualification is suitable for a wide age range.

This qualification provides basic skills and knowledge for a learner go on to further learning, it may enable them to undertake role within a supervised development environment at a junior/trainee level.
