

START IT (ITQ)

Start IT (ITQ) is an entry level 3 qualification for those completely new to ICT or looking to gain confidence to go on to higher qualifications. This is a qualification that provides the flexibility for centres and learners to choose subjects that best meet their needs. It is accredited for the Foundation Learning Tier.

GAINING A START IT (ITQ) OUALIFICATION

Start IT (ITQ) is available in two ways:

- Award requires a minimum of 6 credits and must include IT User fundamentals or Computer Basics and Computer Security and Privacy.
- Certificate requires a minimum of 13 credits and must include IT User fundamentals or Computer Basics and Computer Security and Privacy.

WHY START IT?

The qualification is based on the National Standards and was developed with e-skills UK, the sector skills council for IT and Telecoms, providing an excellent gateway to the ITQ. It has been designed in conjunction with a panel of IT trainers, tutors and college representatives, whose members also developed the assignments.

It is an up-to-date product that will continue to be monitored and developed with centres' and learners' needs in mind, keeping it in line with developments in new technology and the demands of an everyday digital lifestyle.

Start IT (ITQ) also has five units based on the Microsoft Digital Literacy curriculum to allow ease of on-line learning both in the classroom and at home.
