### What does it mean? Some useful words are explained below

#### **Colour spectrum**

Red, orange, yellow, green, blue and violet.



**Complementary colours** Colours that go together well.



**Secondary colours** Violet, orange and green.

#### Mood board

A collection of all your first ideas. It could include examples of hair colour, make-up looks, accessories and materials or clothes.



**Primary colours** Blue, red and yellow.



Total look In the hair and beauty industry this includes hair, make-up and clothes.
