<u>OVERVIEW</u>

What does this qualification cover?

This qualification covers a very wide range of areas related to the skills and knowledge required for preparing to work in the Hairdressing and Barbering Industry.

The following areas that can be covered within this qualification:

The learner will complete four mandatory units at Level 1 and a number of optional units. Mandatory units are:

- Ensure responsibility for actions to reduce risks to health and safety
- Contribute to the development of effective working relationships
- Shampoo and condition hair
- Prepare for hair services and maintain work areas.

The learner will also need to choose from the following optional units:

- Blow dry hair
- Assist with wet shaving
- Assist with colouring
- Assist with perming
- Assist with salon reception duties

This is a Framework qualification.

Who could take this qualification?

For learners starting out in hair and beauty and want a basic understanding of the industry, this qualification is designed for learners who want to prepare for further learning or training in the hair and beauty sector.

This qualification is suitable for anyone from 14 years old or over to take this qualification.
